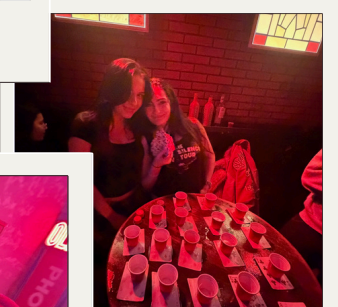
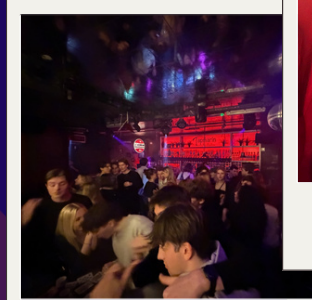

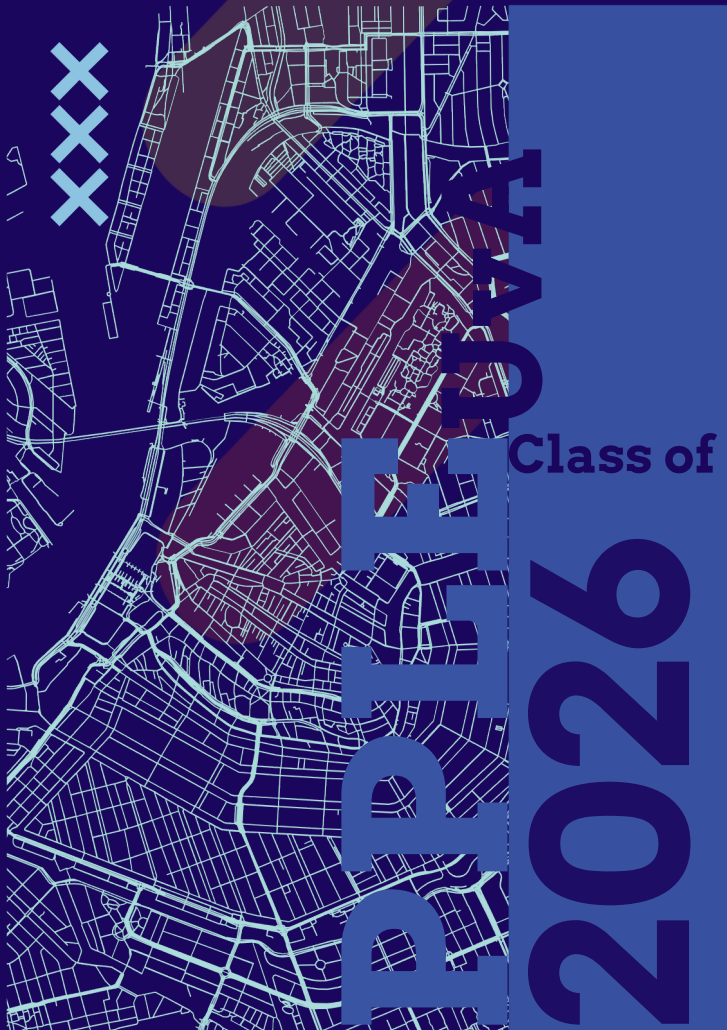
THIRD-YEAR WEEKEND committee
